Wayne played 4 years of varsity football and basketball at Bristol from 1982 to 1986. During the 1985-86 season, he was named Player of the Year in the Bicentennial League, *Courier Times* Player of the Year, and the *Philadelphia Daily News* Suburban Player of the Year in both football and basketball. In football Wayne finished his career with 43 touchdowns and 1,000 receiving yards; he was named to the Pennsylvania Big 33 team. In basketball he finished his career with 2,061 points and 800 assists

After graduating from Bristol, Wayne attended Mercer County Community College in 1986-87 and BYU - Hawaii from 1987 to 1990. He holds 5 records at BYU-Hawaii: most points in a game (43), in a single season (754), most 3-point field goals in a season (101), most assists in a season (216), and most assists in a career (422). Wayne was 1st Team NAIA District 29 in '87-'88 and '88-'89. and NAIA Player of the Year in District 29 in '88-'89.
